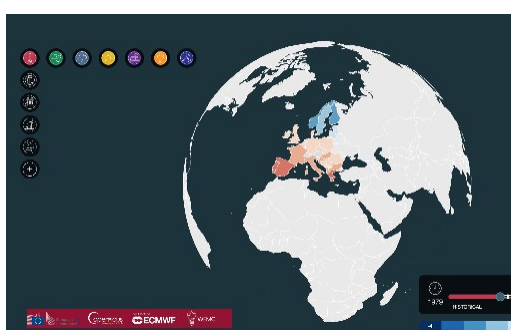




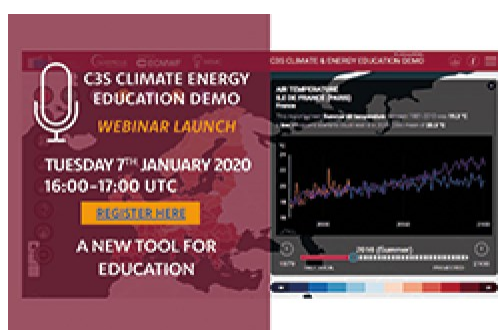
## Welcome to your bumper December newsletter
